

Getting Ready for Your Senior Portraits!

Senior portraits are among the most cherished photos for many of us. At Nagamine Photo Studio, we are honored to capture this time in your life. In this flyer, you'll find valuable tips on how to prepare for your studio session as well as the answers to commonly asked questions.

Some friendly tips to improve your portrait:

HAIR

If you are planning to cut your hair, we recommend that you schedule your hair appointment a week before your photo session to allow your hair time to fill in. Don't make any radical changes to your hairstyle. Chances are you won't feel it expresses the real you.

MAKE-UP

Just before your session, stand two feet in front of the mirror. Dab a small amount of concealer on any noticeable blemishes (make sure it matches your skin tone). That's it! If they aren't visible in front of the mirror, they won't show up in your photos.

TANNING

For the beach lovers: don't over-do it! While we have some incredible retouching talent in our studio, removing peeling skin or a bright red sunburn is next to impossible. A little sun is better than too much.

GLASSES

If you usually wear glasses, you'll want to wear them in your portraits. To completely eliminate any glare, distortion and reflections, it is best to have your optician lend you a pair of frames or remove your lenses. Be sure to give them notice if you decide to do this. PLEASE NOTE: if you come to your session with your glass unaltered, the fee to remove any resulting glare is \$30.00.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Where are you located & what are your hours?

We are located in The Millyard Business Center at 1787 Wili Pa Loop, Unit 2, in Wailuku. Please park in front of our studio in Units 1 & 2. Additional parking may be found on the street. Our current studio and office hours are Tuesday-Friday, 10 am to 2 pm, by appointment only. (Hours are subject to change.)

What do I wear?

Due to current health guidelines, your yearbook photo will be taken in the graduation dress code selected by your school and must be provided by you.

GUYS: long-sleeved collared white shirt with a dark neck tie

GIRLS: black blouse/top/dress with a v-neck or scoop neck (sleeves are recommended). Halter, strapless, spaghetti straps or t-shirt tops will not be allowed.

*The photo you choose for the yearbook must conform to the school's dress code. The studio will not be responsible for any students not conforming to the dress code.

May I bring someone with me to my session?

To better adhere to CDC guidelines, ONE PARENT OR GUARDIAN will be allowed to be present at your photo session.

Do I need to bring any money?

Your session fee must be paid at the time of your appointment. The fee includes the cost of having your portrait in the yearbook. Non-payment may result in your photo not being published in the yearbook.

What about retouching?

All sessions include retouching for the pose selected for the yearbook. All packages also include retouching for the pose(s) ordered. Retouching includes softening of blemishes, bags under the eyes and smile lines. **If you prefer NO RETOUCHING**, please request so at the time of your session.

When can I see my proofs?

Following your photo session, you will be notified when your portraits will be available for viewing on our website. You will also be able to make your selection for the yearbook at this time.

How do I place my order?

You will receive our Summer Specials order form before you leave your photo session. It will have an expiration date, so be sure to place your order by the deadline to take advantage of these special prices! You can order by mail, FAX, or over the phone. There is an online ordering option as well.
